



ENERGY SHARE



Energy Share is a Southwest Gas emergency fund which provides direct utility assistance to qualified customers with unexpected financial difficulties. Energy Share also provides emergency repairs and/or replacement of eligible natural gas equipment or appliances.

If you are a current Southwest Gas customer and are experiencing a unexpected financial hardship you may qualify for assistance through Energy Share. Applications for the Energy Share are available in the ERS Department at HELP of Southern Nevada Monday – Thursday, 7am to 5pm and are accepted on a walk-in basis or by appointment. **For an appointment call (702)369-4357 x1231, 1277 OR 1823**

Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Verified Southwest Gas account holder and/or household member
- Must have valid Nevada id
- Has not received Energy SHARE assistance during the past twelve months
- Verified financial crisis or unexpected financial difficulty or hardship preventing payment of gas utility bill, including without limitation, (i) a loss or reduction in household income; (ii) a loss, reduction or delay in receipt of public assistance benefits to the household; or (iii) an unexpected or unplanned expense causing lack of financial resources
- For emergency repairs and/or replacement of eligible natural gas equipment or appliance, (1) a condition that endangers the health and safety of household members; (2) proof of ownership of appliance or equipment; and (3) verified household income equal to or less than 150% of the current Federal Poverty Income Guidelines

Required Documents

Identification for all adults in the household
Birth certificates for children in the household
Social security card for all members of the household
Proof of income for all members of the household
Southwest gas bill (name & address must match household member's ID)
Lease/mortgage statement
Evidence of need
