Are you having trouble making ends meet? Are you able to meet the nutritional needs for yourself or your family? You may be qualified for benefits under the USDA (SNAP)

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

To find out more or apply for this program, call Bill Scala at 369-4357 ext.1227. If you are eligible an appointment will be made & the following documents will be needed:

- Valid picture identification & Social Security cards for all persons being included in the Food Stamp (SNAP) household (A#{Residence Card} for non-US citizens)
- Birth Certificates for anyone under 22 yrs. old.
- Proof of monthly income: paystubs last 60 days
- Other resources: unemployment, SSI,RSDI,VA,etc....
- Rental or mortgage documents in the applicants name (rent payment receipts are acceptable)
- Letter from owner if renting a room or living with friends.(Owners signature, address & phone number)
- Latest bank statement if applicable
- Latest utility bills – electric, gas, water, etc.
- Child support documents (paying out or receiving)
- Medical & Child Care Expenses
- Vehicle Registration

This program could mean the difference between hunger and nutritional meals for you and/or your family. Don't let this opportunity go by.
